Rules and Regulations

1. Objectives of the tournament: to promote Chinese martial arts culture, encourage the public to actively participate in Chinese martial arts exercises, improve skills through competition, enhance physical fitness and strive for self-improvement.

2. Target participants: Martial Arts elites, groups, institutions and schools from all over the world are welcomed to sign up

3. Competition items: Chinese Martial Arts

4. Mode of competition: Cyber platform

5. Age limit: No age limit

6. Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze

7. Judges: a team of experienced Hong Kong referees

8. Fees:

- 1) Registration fee: HK\$150 or USD20 per individual per entry
- 2) Sparring / dismantling with partner : HK\$150 or USD20 per person per entry
- 3) Group competition: HK\$130 or USD17 per person

Note: Each person is limited to three entries, and no less than five members per team in a group event

Eligibility to participate will be confirmed only after the organizer has received all the documents and required information.

12. Application deadline:

Submit completed application with payment on or before **7 May 2022**.
Once it was confirmed, fees are not refundable.

12. Deadline for submitting video:

Entries (video short) must be submitted on or before **7 May 2022**, otherwise they will be disqualified.

13. Date of scoring: 22 May 2022 (Sunday)

14. Tournament video time length restrictions :

- 1) Fist techniques, equipment, pair practice or martial arts exercises shall not exceed 2 minutes or less than 30 seconds
- 2) Tai Chi, traditional skills and Qigong cannot be longer than 4 minutes or less than 30 seconds

15. Notes for video shots:

Film and video requirements: the video must be clear, with obvious luminosity and minimum resolution of 1080 pixels. Violated submissions will not be processed

16. Contestants must wear martial arts clothes or sportswear for video shooting of the whole competition. Violated submissions will not be processed

17. There is no size limit on the drill site, but it needs to be open and flat

18. Athletes are not allowed to leave the video screen before the completion of the recording. Violated submissions will not be processed.

19. All footage must be shot in one take. If the video is found to have been edited.

Violated submissions will not be processed.

20. The video cannot create any special effects or match music to enhance the effect of the drill.

Violated submissions will not be processed.

21. Please review the video carefully before submitting, it must be original and cannot be used from previous entries.

22. Competition videos must be filmed in accordance with the requirements of the regulations

23. Event announcement:

The results will be announced on Facebook and Weibo on **22, May 2022** after being graded by the organizer.

24. Award arrangement:

after the competition, the medals and certificates will be mailed to the winners according to the address filled in the registration form, and the mailing freight will be paid on arrival. Award-winners in Hong Kong can also be collected in person during office hours at **room 1203, Yuan Shing Industrial Building, 1033 Yee Kuk West Street, Lai Chi Kok, Hong Kong**

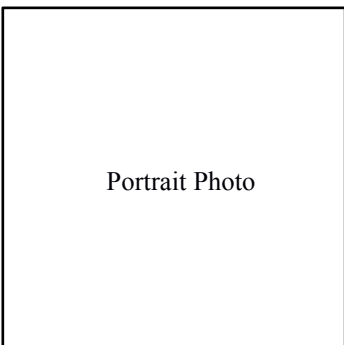
